THE TICA BY-LAWS STATE:

14.1 Breed Section. A Breed Section(s) shall be established for each breed or breed group and one or more sections for household pets. Each member shall automatically be eligible to apply to belong to one Breed/Breed Group Section as a part of his or her membership.

14.1.1 Any member may belong to additional Breed/Breed Group Sections by applying for and paying an additional fee AND by showing proof of one of the following:

- 14.1.1.1 Individual registration of a cat of the breed/breed group in the three years immediately preceding application.
- 14.1.1.2 Registration of a litter of the breed/breed group in the three years immediately preceding application.
- 14.1.1.3 Showing a kitten, cat, or alter of the breed/breed group in the three years immediately preceding application.
- 14.1.1.4 Ownership of a kitten, cat or alter of the breed/breed group.

113.1 Qualification. Each member in good standing, one whose dues are paid and who has no outstanding indebtedness to TICA or to any TICA club, and who is not/was not on the Temporary Suspension List on the qualifying date, who was a member in good standing 6 months prior to the first day of the month in which a ballot is to be mailed, shall be eligible to vote.

114.2 Announcement of Candidates. After the initial election, any member who has been a member in good standing for 2 consecutive years immediately preceding shall be eligible to seek office and shall declare his candidacy in writing to the Executive Office not more than 6 months nor less than 2 months before the election month with the filing fee established by the Board of Directors. If no member in the region or no member in the breed section has been a member for the 2 years immediately preceding the election, the 2 year membership requirement shall not apply. This shall entitle the candidate to be listed as a candidate for the office sought in every issue of the newsletter including the newsletter prior to the ballot being mailed to the membership. Each candidate shall be entitled to publish a summary of his/her experience, credentials and platform in accordance with Standing Rules 1014.3. No other advertisement, endorsement or article on any candidacy may be printed in the official newsletter. Candidates who are drafted by write-in vote of the membership shall fulfill all qualifications of those filing for office.

15.4.2 Qualifications for Election to a Breed Committee. Candidates for election to a Breed Committee shall provide <sup>1467</sup> documentation of having met the following requirements for election: 4 2013

- ✓ 15.4.2.1 Have met the eligibility requirement(s) to vote in any TICA election (See By-Laws. 113.1)
  - ✓ 15.4.2.2 Have met the requirements for breed section membership (See By-Laws 14.1)
  - ✓ 15.4.2.3 Have paid TICA membership dues for the 3 years of the applicable term.
  - ✓ 15.4.2.4 Have a TICA Registered Cattery (except for the HHP Breed Committee).
  - ✓ 15.4.2.5.1 Have bred and registered with TICA a minimum of two litters of the appropriate breed within the 3 years immediately preceding the election (except for the HHP Breed Committee).
- OR
- ✓ 15.4.2.5.2 Have owned and shown a cat of the appropriate breed in a minimum of five shows within the three show seasons immediately preceding the election. (Note: Applicants for Household Pet Breed Committee(s) must meet this requirement to qualify for breed committee election.)

15.4.3 No member shall be a member of more than three breed committees.

15.5 No person shall be eligible to serve as an elected officer of this Association who is an officer of another similar association, or who has any outstanding indebtedness to TICA or to a TICA club.

**Comments:**

(AB) Are we defining registry somewhere? If not, do we need to? Is our definition of Registry including club issued pedigrees where the club is affiliated with a registry? Also, some of the international pedigrees I've seen basically are the litter registration form as well -- they list all the kittens in the litter on some of them. Apparently there is also a pedigree central type if group. Katerina Krenn's club uses it to check pedigrees -- maybe it would make sense to ask her for some input?

(EC) I'm not sure that registries outside of North America have litter registrations - can we check on that?

(BT) I thought we were going to have a Standing Rule covering the fact that we understand that there may not be an actual registration certificate in some registries and that the pedigree would suffice in those instances.

(MW) My view is that the form should NOT be defined as part of the Registration Rules, as it is operational rather than policy. I can say that both GCCF and the UK FIFe member have the ability to register a litter (called "declaring") though I don't know what documentation is produced.

## Amendment Proposal A:

### ARTICLE TWO – Shows

22.2 Format. The sponsoring club shall determine the format of the show. The show may be 1 day, 2 days, or more, or a back-to-back show format, and must be advertised as such on all materials promoting the show.

22.2.1 A back-to-back show is two or more shows, held on consecutive days. For scoring purposes, each day is considered a different show. With the following exceptions:

22.2.1.1 If May 1 is a Sunday in any given year, all shows on any day in that same weekend shall be scored in the show year ending April 30 of that year.

22.2.1.2 If May 1 is a Saturday in any given year, all shows on any day in that same weekend, including shows held on Friday, shall be scored in the show year beginning May 1 of that year.

22.2.2 An Alternative Format show is a show in which two separate shows are held consecutively, but in the same calendar day. Each show shall be scored as a separate show.

22.2.2.1 A club located in an Isolated Area may sponsor an Alternative Format Show any time.

22.2.2.2 A club not located in an Isolated Area may sponsor an Alternative Format show only with the advance permission of the Regional Director.

---

*202.2 Maximum number of times any single cat may be judged on any show weekend is **as follows: twenty including congresses, regardless of format.***

*202.2.1 One-Day Alternative Format shows may have up to five rings in the morning and five in the afternoon for a weekend maximum total of 10 rings including Congresses. A 1-day alternative format show **with more than 8 rings** may not be combined with any other format.*

*202.2.2 Two-Day Alternative Format shows may have **up to** four rings in the morning and **up to** four rings in the afternoon for a daily total of eight rings and a weekend total of sixteen rings including Congresses. **Two-day alternative format shows may not be combined with any other format.***

***202.2.2.1 In non-isolated areas a judge may not judge more than two Alternative Format shows on the same weekend, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.***

*202.2.3 At Back-to-Back Shows or Split Format (**2-Day**) Shows any single cat may be judged not more than eight times per day, including any Congresses. **The maximum number of times a cat may be judged in a show weekend is twenty.***

***202.2.4 Examples of allowable ring combinations are:***

***202.2.4.1 Four rings on Friday with eight on Saturday and eight on Sunday – Each cat judged 20 times but not more than eight times per day.***

***202.2.4.2 Six rings on Friday with seven on Saturday and seven on Sunday – Each cat judged 20 times but not more than eight times per day.***

***202.2.4.3 Eight rings on Saturday and eight on Sunday – Each day has the maximum of eight times so the total for the weekend can only be sixteen.***

***202.2.4.4 Four rings on Friday, seven rings on Saturday plus a Senior Congress and a Junior Congress, and seven rings on Sunday plus a Male Congress and a Female Congress. The congresses are on different days and any single cat will only be in one congress per day thus will only be judged a maximum of eight times per day and twenty times that weekend.***

***202.2.5 Shows in non-isolated areas that have been advertised as back-to-back, 2-day or split format, may not change to Alternative Format.***

***202.2.4 A club may choose to have different formats for each day of a show. (For example, a club may opt to have a one-day Alternative format show on Saturday with four rings in the morning and four rings in the afternoon and a one-day show on Sunday with five rings.) The show format(s) must be clearly advertised in all promotional material.***

22.3 Entries.

*202.3 The maximum number of times a judge may judge any single cat on a show weekend is as follows:*

*202.3.1 Two times in 1 day.*

*202.3.2 Three times in 2 days.*

*202.3.3 Four times in 3 days.*

22.3.1 The maximum number of entries a club may accept is limited as follows:

22.3.1.1 Alternative Format - 125 entries. (See Show Rule 21.16.)

22.3.1.2 Back-to-Back Format - 250 entries. (See Show Rule 21.14.)

22.3.1.3 Split Format (**2-day Show**) - **500 250** entries **per day**. (See Show Rule 21.15 and Show Rule 216.4.)

## Amendment Proposal B:

### ARTICLE TWO – Shows

22.2 Format. The sponsoring club shall determine the format of the show. The show may be 1 day, 2 days, or more, or a back-to-back show format, and must be advertised as such on all materials promoting the show.

***202.2.2.1 In non-isolated areas a judge may not judge more than two Alternative Format shows on the same weekend, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.***

*202.2.3 At Back-to-Back Shows or Split Format (**2-Day**) Shows any single cat may be judged not more than eight times per day, including any Congresses. **The maximum number of times a cat may be judged in a show weekend is twenty.***

***202.2.4 Examples of allowable ring combinations are:***

***202.2.4.1 Four rings on Friday with eight on Saturday and eight on Sunday – Each cat judged 20 times but not more than eight times per day.***

***202.2.4.2 Six rings on Friday with seven on Saturday and seven on Sunday – Each cat judged 20 times but not more than eight times per day.***

***202.2.4.3 Eight rings on Saturday and eight on Sunday – Each day has the maximum of eight times so the total for the weekend can only be sixteen.***

***202.2.4.4 Four rings on Friday, seven rings on Saturday plus a Senior Congress and a Junior Congress, and seven rings on Sunday plus a Male Congress and a Female Congress. The congresses are on different days and any single cat will only be in one congress per day thus will only be judged a maximum of eight times per day and twenty times that weekend.***

***202.2.5 Shows in non-isolated areas that have been advertised as back-to-back, 2-day or split format, may not change to Alternative Format.***

***202.2.4 A club may choose to have different formats for each day of a show. (For example, a club may opt to have a one-day Alternative format show on Saturday with four rings in the morning and four rings in the afternoon and a one-day show on Sunday with five rings.) The show format(s) must be clearly advertised in all promotional material.***

22.3 Entries.

*202.3 The maximum number of times a judge may judge any single cat on a show weekend is as follows:*

***202.3.1 Two times in 1 day.***

***202.3.2 Three times in 2 days.***

***202.3.3 Four times in 3 days.***

**202.3.1 In non-Isolated Areas, two times per show weekend, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.**

**202.3.2 In Isolated Areas, two times in 1 day, three times in 2 days or four times in 3 days, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.**

22.3.1 The maximum number of entries a club may accept is limited as follows:

22.3.1.1 Alternative Format - 125 entries. (See Show Rule 21.16.)

22.3.1.2 Back-to-Back Format - 250 entries. (See Show Rule 21.14.)

22.3.1.3 Split Format (**2-day Show**) - **500 250** entries **per day**. (See Show Rule 21.15 and Show Rule 216.4.)

## Amendment Proposal C:

### ARTICLE TWO – Shows

22.2 Format. The sponsoring club shall determine the format of the show. The show may be 1 day, 2 days, or more, or a back-to-back show format, and must be advertised as such on all materials promoting the show.

22.2.1 A back-to-back show is two or more shows, held on consecutive days. For scoring purposes, each day is considered a different show. With the following exceptions:

202.2.1 *One-Day Alternative Format shows may have up to five rings in the morning and five in the afternoon for a weekend maximum total of 10 rings including Congresses. A 1-day alternative format show **with more than 8 rings** may not be combined with any other format.*

202.2.2 *Two-Day Alternative Format shows may have **up to** four rings in the morning and **up to** four rings in the afternoon for a daily total of eight rings and a weekend total of sixteen rings including Congresses. **Two-day alternative format shows may not be combined with any other format.***

202.2.4.3 ***Eight rings on Saturday and eight on Sunday – Each day has the maximum of eight times so the total for the weekend can only be sixteen.***

202.2.4.4 ***Four rings on Friday, seven rings on Saturday plus a Senior Congress and a Junior Congress, and seven rings on Sunday plus a Male Congress and a Female Congress. The congresses are on different days and any single cat will only be in one congress per day thus will only be judged a maximum of eight times per day and twenty times that weekend.***

202.2.5 ***Shows in non-isolated areas that have been advertised as back-to-back, 2-day or split format, may not change to Alternative Format.***

202.2.4 ***A club may choose to have different formats for each day of a show. (For example, a club may opt to have a one-day Alternative format show on Saturday with four rings in the morning and four rings in the afternoon and a one-day show on Sunday with five rings.) The show format(s) must be clearly advertised in all promotional material.***

---

## 22.3 Entries.

---

*202.3 The maximum number of times a judge may judge any single cat on a show weekend is as follows:*

***202.3.1 Two times in 1 day.***

***202.3.2 Three times in 2 days.***

***202.3.3 Four times in 3 days.***

***202.3.1 In Established Areas, two times per show weekend, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.***

***202.3.2 In Developing Areas, two times in 1 day or 2 days, three times in 3 days, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.***

***202.3.3 In Isolated/Foundation Areas, two times in 1 day, three times in 2 days or four times in 3 days, except in cases of emergency whereby a contracted judge has canceled and a new (i.e. different) judge cannot be contracted.***

---

22.3.1 The maximum number of entries a club may accept is limited as follows:

22.3.1.1 Alternative Format - 125 entries. (See Show Rule 21.16.)

22.3.1.2 Back-to-Back Format - 250 entries. (See Show Rule 21.14.)

22.3.1.3 Split Format (***2-day Show***) - ***500 250*** entries ***per day***. (See Show Rule 21.15 and Show Rule 216.4.)

### **Comments:**

(AB) I think Option is the one to implement strategically. While we could implement Options A or B (and I prefer B to A) in a tactical timeframe, I would recommend Option C as the strategic implementation we should work towards. If we implement Options A or B now and then Option C at a later point, we will be creating extra work. Better to do the additional Rules work now and implement the strategic solution right from the start.

(MW) Option C is probably the best option long-term for TICA. However, it does require additional work - other rules which will need re-defining - which I do not see being completed by mid-March. It also introduces new concepts which (a) the Board need to get familiar with first and (b) the board committee looking at expansion into what Carlos has termed "Foundation Areas" has yet to report back. Options A and B are effectively ready for the Board to vote on at the Spring Meeting. With one exception, the changes in Options A and B are all in Standing Rules and therefore do not need a membership ballot. I do not believe that the one Show Rule change (23.3.1.3) is actually necessary. There has been comment that these changes must only take place at the start of a show season, because "it affects the way a cat is shown". I would argue that the changes to the Standing Rules merely impact the number of rings available over a show weekend and not the actual showing process or title points. Yes it would have some impact on standings, but I'd also argue that making the change early in the show season should minimise that impact. I therefore think that Options A and B could be implemented immediately if the Board chooses to approve one of them at the Spring Meeting.

## Amend UCD Color Descriptions to Include Shaded Points

**Workitem Description:** The UCD is missing the descriptions for shaded points. Define the descriptions.

**Rationale:** Complete the UCD Color Descriptions

**Amendments:** Add the following descriptions:

**Blue Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside of tail glacial white, sprinkling of pale blue-grey tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in pale blue-grey. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is blue-grey. Skin pigment around nose is slate. Heels and topside of tail tipped in blue-grey to slate.

**Blue Silver Shaded Torbie Point:** Same as Blue Silver Shaded Point with patches of cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

**Chocolate Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside of tail white, sprinkling of light cocoa tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in light cocoa. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is cocoa. Skin pigment around nose is dark chocolate. Heels and topside of tail tipped in cocoa to dark chocolate.

**Chocolate Silver Shaded Torbie Point:** Same as Chocolate Silver Shaded Point with patches of red/cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

**Cinnamon Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside of tail white, sprinkling of pale honey tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in pale honey. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is honey. Skin pigment around nose is light warm brown. Heels and topside of tail tipped in honey to light warm brown.

**Cinnamon Silver Shaded Point:** Same as Cinnamon Silver Shaded Point with patches of red/cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

**Cream Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside of tail snow white, sprinkling of pale sand tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in pale sand. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is sand. Skin pigment around nose is pink. Backs of legs and topside of tail tipped in sand to champagne.

**Fawn Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside of tail white, sprinkling of cool beige tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in cool beige. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is beige. Skin pigment around nose is taupe. Heels and topside of tail tipped in beige to taupe.

**Fawn Silver Shaded Torbie Point:** Same as Fawn Silver Shaded Point with patches of cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

**Lilac Silver Shaded Point:** Body, legs and underside white, sprinkling of pale dove-grey tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in pale dove-grey. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is dove-grey. Skin pigment around nose is deep lavender. Heels and topside of tail tipped in dove-grey to deep lavender.



Lilac Silver Shaded Torbie Point: Same as Lilac Silver Shaded Point with patches of cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

Red Silver Shaded Point: Body, legs and underside of tail snow white, sprinkling of pale peach tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in pale peach. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is peach. Skin pigment around nose is pink. Heels and topside of tail tipped in peach to apricot.

Seal Silver Shaded Point: Body, legs and underside of tail ice white, sprinkling of brushed aluminum tipping on back permissible. Ears uniformly tipped in brushed aluminum. Muzzle same color as ears. Slight facial barring is aluminum. Skin pigment around nose is platinum-grey. Heels and topside of tail tipped in aluminum to platinum-grey.

Seal Silver Shaded Torbie Point: Same as Seal Silver Shaded Point with patches of red/cream. Torbie shaded points can have very little evidence of red/cream, sometimes just a toe or a spot on the muzzle, forehead or tail.

**Pros:** Includes the color descriptions or the shaded points.

**Cons:** None.

## Amend UCD Color Descriptions to Include Amber/Light Amber (Bird)

Work item:

Add Color Descriptions for Amber/Light Amber.

Rationale:

TICA accepts Amber/Light Amber now that testing has confirmed it is the result of the extension gene.

Amendment: Add the following to the UCD:

71.5 TICA accepts three pigment genotypes resulting in three dense (D/-) black-based colors (black, chocolate, cinnamon) and three dilute (d/d) colors (blue, lilac, fawn), plus red (D/-) and cream (d/d) which are the result of the sex-linked red allele (O). In Norwegian Forest Cats only, TICA also accepts amber (D/-) and light amber (d/d) which are the result of an extension gene allele (ea/ ea).

71.5.1 The full color (dense) non-dilute in the black-based series is black. There are two alleles which produce brownish pigment, chocolate and cinnamon, with chocolate being the darker and cinnamon the lighter. Blue, the dilution of black, when combined with chocolate or cinnamon produces lilac or fawn, respectively. Sex-linked red changes the appearance of all non-dilute dense colors to red, and changes blue, lilac and fawn to cream. For purposes of exhibition, no distinction is made between the shades of red or the shades of cream.

71.6.1 A breed may accept a single pigment genotype with or without its dilution; however, a breed which accepts pigment genotype B/- and either other pigment genotype must accept all pigment genotypes. (See chart 71.5)

71.6.2 A breed which recognizes cats in all eight divisions of a category must accept all colors of these divisions, with the exception of amber and light amber.

71.6.3 A breed may be recognized in white only. However, if other colors are recognized in addition to dominant (epistatic) white (W/-), the breed must accept all colors of all divisions which are accepted by that breed.

71.6.4 A breed may choose to recognize only the black-based (eumelanistic) colors or the sex-linked red-based colors. Recognition of both implies automatic acceptance of the corresponding tortoiseshells as well.

**Amber:** Kittens start out looking like one of the eumelanistic colors, but the eumelanistic color is gradually replaced during the first year of life by pheomelanin. Mature adult cats will range anywhere from a deep burnt sienna, a warm apricot, a rich copper brown, tan, or yellow to a cold beige or grey-beige color depending on the amount of rufousing present. Skin around eyes, on the lips, nose, and paw pads retains the dark color of the cat's eumelanistic genotype. For example, a black amber tabby will have black eyeliner, black lips, black nose leather, and black paw pads.

**Light Amber:** Kittens start out looking like one of the dilute eumelanistic colors, but that is gradually replaced during the first year of life by dilute pheomelanin. Range from pale bluish ivory to a buff or oatmeal to a warm fawn, depending on the amount of rufousing present. Skin will retain the color of the cat's dilute eumelanistic genotype. For example, a blue amber tabby will have blue eyeliner, blue lips, blue nose leather, and blue paw pads.

(CL) In this way we are only limiting the Amber to NFCs.

(AB) I would rather see it remain open so that if Amber occurs in other breeds in the future we don't have to come back in and make a change to the UCD to add the new breed.
